



Data Tip: Reporting Early Childhood and Preschool Data

Definition:

Early childhood refers to early childhood education programs and services for children **birth through age 2**.

What data are reported for early childhood programs/services only?

- Yes/No indication of whether the LEA provides early childhood services or programs that serve children birth through age 2 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indication of whether any of the LEA's early childhood services or programs serve non-IDEA children birth through age 2 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)

Definition:

Preschool refers to preschool programs and services for children **ages 3 through 5**.

What data are reported for preschool programs/services or preschool children only?

- Yes/No indication of whether the LEA provides preschool services or programs that serve children ages 3 through 5 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indication of daily length and costs associated with the LEA's preschool services or programs that serve children ages 3 through 5 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indication of whether any of the LEA's preschool services or programs serve non-IDEA children, by age – 3, 4, or 5 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indication of whether the LEA offers its preschool services or programs to all children ages 3 through 5 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indication of whether the LEA's preschool services or programs are offered to IDEA children, children in Title I schools, or children from low income families (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Count of children served in the LEA's preschool services or programs, by age – 2, 3, 4, or 5 (LEA Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indication of whether any of the school's preschool services or programs serve non-IDEA children, by age – 3, 4, or 5 (School Form Part 1, Section I)
- Count of preschool child enrollment (School Form Part 1, Section II)
- Count of preschool children who receive corporal punishment (School Form Part 2, Section VII)



- Count of instances of corporal punishment for preschool children (School Form Part 2, Section VII)
- Count of preschool children who receive suspensions or expulsion (School Form Part 2, Section VII)
- Count of instances of suspension for preschool children (School Form Part 2, Section VII)

Which data elements include preschool children?

- Yes/No indicator of whether the school offers a grade where at least one child is enrolled (School Form Part 1, Section I)
- Count of overall student enrollment (School Form Part 1, Section II)
- Count of LEP student enrollment (School Form Part 1, Section II)
- Enrollment count of students with disabilities (School Form Part 1, Section II)
- Yes/No indicator of whether school has any students enrolled in gifted/talented programs (School Form Part 1, Section III)
- Count of gifted/talented student enrollment (School Form Part 1, Section III)
- Count of FTE teachers—total, certified, and not certified (School Form Part 1, Section IV)
- Count of FTE teachers, by years of experience (School Form Part 1, Section IV)
- Count of teachers—for current year; for previous year (School Form Part 1, Section IV)
- Count of FTE school counselors (School Form Part 1, Section IV)
- Count of FTE security staff (School Form Part 1, Section IV)
- Count of FTE support services staff (School Form Part 1, Section IV)
- Yes/No indicator of whether the school has any students who receive corporal punishment (School Form Part 2, Section VII)
- Count of incidents of offenses (School Form Part 2, Section VIII)
- Yes/No indicator of whether there has been a shooting incident at the school (School Form Part 2, Section VIII)
- Yes/No indicator of whether any of the school's students, faculty, or staff have died as a result of a school homicide (School Form Part 2, Section VIII)
- Count of FTE teachers absent more than 10 school days (School Form Part 2, Section XI)
- Salary amount for teachers funded with federal, state, and local funds (School Form Part 2, Section XII)
- FTE counts and salary amounts for staff funded with federal, state, and local funds (School Form Part 2, Section XII)
- Salary amount for total personnel funded with federal, state, and local funds (School Form Part 2, Section XII)
- Amount for non-personnel expenditures associated with activities funded with federal, state, and local funds (School Form Part 2, Section XII)
